SOUMISSION D'ABSTRACT

Preparing an abstract for submission

Abstracts should be written in clear and concise English. The word limit for abstracts is **300 words**. Titles, authors, authors' affiliations, and e-mail of the presenting author are not included in the 300-word limit. The abstract must contain a brief statement of:

- The hypothesis or objectives of the investigation,
- Experimental methods used,
- Essential results, including data and, where appropriate statistics,
- Conclusion

Please also specify your abstract category:

- Microbiology
- Vegetal physiology, Environmental science
- Neuroscience, Healthy, Animal physiology
