Objectives in terms of educational content and framework:

The successful candidate will join the teaching team of the Networks and Telecommunications (R&T) department at the IUT Grand-Ouest Normandie (campus 3 in Ifs). In addition to the teaching activities described below, the candidate will participate in the supervision of interns and apprentices, as well as in departmental events: academic and departmental councils (3 or 4 per year), open house (1 per year), and student fair (1 per year).

Subjects taught:

The successful candidate will be expected to:

- primarily as a practical (or tutorial) instructor in the first year
- as a lecturer and/or instructor for learning and assessment situations (i.e., projects) in subsequent years.

The main areas of expertise are:

- Virtualization and containerization: VirtualBox, Proxmox, Docker, Vagrant/Packer, etc.
- Linux and Windows system administration: Bash/PowerShell, LDAP/AD, etc.
- Networking: IPv4/IPv6, NAT, LAN/WAN, etc.
- Network services: DNS/DNSSEC, DHCP, etc.
- Cybersecurity: penetration testing, firewalls, cryptographic tools, etc.
